

Urgent Formula Recall Information

Abbott has issued a recall notice for several of their powder infant formulas. If the formula you have is **not** affected by the recall, it is safe to use.

How to find out if your formula is included in the recall:

- Enter the lot number into the Similac Recall site: www.similacrecall.com

Or

- Call 1-800-986-8540

The lot number is on the bottom of the can near the expiration date (see image below).

Affected products have lot numbers with all three of the following:

- The first two digits between 22 through 37, **and**
- A code on the container contains K8, SH, or Z2, **and**
- An expiration date of 04/01/2022 or later.



If the formula you have has been recalled:

- Do **NOT** use the formula.

Some options to exchange or replace it are:

- Call Abbott directly at 1-800-986-8540. They may be able to provide replacement formula, but it may take time to receive the product.
- Check with your grocery store or pharmacy to see if they can exchange the recalled formula.

WIC Participants:

If you cannot find replacement formula in the store

- Use SNAP benefits if available. Store formulas are often less expensive and can be an appropriate substitution.
- Check with your local food bank or food pantry.
