

OUR HISTORY

The Family Strength Program began as a grant funded program provided by Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA). The grant was awarded in 2013 and the program became self-sustaining in 2018.

FOCUS

Our focus is to collaborate with those involved in the child's care using a wraparound approach. The program is focused on individual values and strives to meet the client where they are at in life. The Family Strength Program is community and school-based to provide services needed to heal. We strive to be strength-based, allowing you take the lead and knowing what works for your family.

TRAUMA INFORMED

We guide families as they heal. Trauma can be defined as an event or series of events that cause emotional distress reactions. Trauma can be events such as injury, death or loss of someone close, separation of family, exposure to violence, experiencing abuse, or natural disaster.

Historical trauma such as forced relocation, colonization, loss of language, and boarding schools can continue to impact the future generations of those who experienced such events.

REFERRAL PROCESS
