Utilizing the Johns Hopkins University Family Spirit Home Visiting curriculum, the Átawišamataš Programs offers services to pregnant persons, families, and guardians who have children 5 and under in the home. Family Spirit is an evidence-based home visiting program developed for and with Indigenous communities.

WHO CAN ENROLL?

- Yellowhawk eligible patients that meet any of the following criteria:
 - Parent/families/guardians with children ages 5 years and under in their home
 - Patients with a confirmed pregnancy with any OB provider

SERVICES OFFERED

- Help families have a healthy pregnancy
- Build a support network for families
- Make homes a safe place for families to live and play
 - Linking families to community services to address specific needs
- Encouragement of your child's growth and development
 - Parenting knowledge & skill building
 - Prepare children for early school success
- Assist with opportunities to continue education and develop job skills
- Future goal setting and creating plans to reach them
- Various other support services
